Based on the operating data provided, your 43 CHP projects have avoided emissions of an estimated 4,700 metric tons of carbon dioxide, compared to conventional energy sources. This includes 2015 avoided emissions of more than 1,090 metric tons, equal to those from the generation of electricity used annually by 150 homes.
